Applications:

Accompany your application with a currently dated check or money order (payable to *Monroe Congregational Church*) and **pictures** including: **your booth, your display, your art or craftwork**. Even if you have been previously accepted, we require pictures every year. Photos will be returned at check-in.

Application deadline is April 30, 2025. There will be no refunds for withdrawal after May 1, 2025.

Applications received prior to April 30, 2025 will be evaluated by May 31, 2025.

Applications received after the April 30 deadline will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis and accepted as space allows until two weeks before the event.

Selection committee rules:

- 1. Crafters may only show and sell **their handmade** items.
- 2. Manufactured and commercial reproductions are not acceptable.
- 3. Crafts from commercial kits are not acceptable.
- 4. Only 2 (two) categories of craft per space are allowed.

The festival committee reserves the right to request the removal of any work not officially accepted during the jury process or that does not otherwise meet the standards for the show.
