Set-up: Friday after 6:30 PM and Saturday after 7:00 AM.

Boy Scouts are available to help unload your vehicle at those times; Sunday, too, for pack-up at 5:00 PM. The Boy Scouts camp on the green Friday and Saturday nights to safeguard the exhibitor tents.

Breakdown: No breakdowns until 5:00 PM Sunday.

Amenities:

- Complimentary coffee and pastries served Saturday and Sunday morning **until 9:45 AM.**
- Other amenities to be determined closer to the date, dependent on CDC Guidelines and the Town of Monroe Health Department (PF Food booth, Masonic Lodge Country Breakfast)

Applications:

Accompany your application with a currently dated check (payable to *Monroe Congregational Church*) and **pictures** including: **your booth, your display, your art or craftwork.** Even if you have been previously accepted, we require pictures every year. Photos will be returned after check-in.

Application deadline is April 30, 2022. There will be no refunds for withdrawal after May 1, 2022.

→ *If you are a returning crafter and want your same space, we may not be able to guarantee that this year. We will try to place you as close as possible, while keeping booths separated.* ←

Applications received by April 30, 2022 will be answered by May 31, 2022.

Selection committee rules:

1. Crafters may only show and sell their **handmade** items.
2. Manufactured and commercial reproductions are not acceptable.
3. Crafts from commercial kits are not acceptable.
4. Only 2 (two) categories of craft per space will be allowed.

The festival committee reserves the right to request the removal of any work not officially accepted during the jury process, or does not otherwise meet the standards for the show.
