Applications received after the deadline will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis and accepted as space allows.

Selection committee rules:

- 1. Crafters may only show and sell *their handmade* items.
- 2. Manufactured and commercial reproductions are not acceptable.
- 3. Crafts from commercial kits are not acceptable.
- 4. Only 2 (two) categories of craft per space will be allowed.

The festival committee reserves the right to request the removal of any work not officially accepted during the jury process or does not otherwise meet the standards for the show.
