In-Person, Outdoor, Socially Distanced Senior PF to begin May 31st

As our state begins to slowly open back up, it's time to think about what leaning into that might look like at church. I've spent time closely researching and monitoring CDC protocol for houses of worship, our regional minister's recommendations, and local conditions (including regular communication with our town's Board of Health). The adult advisors and high school leadership team will be able to begin a no-contact, outdoor, socially distanced PF program for our high schoolers beginning on May 31st at 5 pm. Our junior high youth group (Jr PF) will continue a zoom-only platform for now.

Protocols for In-Person, Outdoor, Socially Distanced Senior PF

- If you have a cough (not allergy related)/fever, you must stay home
- PF takes place outside (bring lawn chair)
- Masks are mandatory (we will have extras), maintain physical 6 ft distance
- No sharing food (bring your own snack)
- No singing (aerosolizes germs 20 ft)
- No immediate contact (hugs, holding hands)
- Wash hands frequently (will setup outdoor hand wash station, hand sanitizer)
- Bathrooms are a source of cross contamination, please try to limit their use if at all possible
- No Summer PF's at individual's home (need to control safety conditions, puts an unfair burden on hosting family)
- If protocols can't be followed, or if conditions in our local area change, we will discontinue in-person PF and resume to a Zoom-only alternative
